



# Working together to deliver place-based health and care

## Masterclass programme for health and housing

The New NHS Alliance and CIH consultancy are offering a new action research programme for a limited number of health and housing professionals working within the same locality to learn, innovate and implement new services together. This is a fast-track programme designed to achieve rapid change in service design between the NHS and core community-based partners as a key strand of the new models of care programme.

Housing and health are key partners in the transformation to place-based working. The requirement to generate sustainability and transformation plans is just the start of a journey that will see the work of health, housing and care professionals and other community-based organisations increasingly coalesce around places and people. An increasing focus on prevention, health creation and out-of-hospital care will require new services that involve new community-based partners and that bear little resemblance to existing models of service provision.

The programme will run for a period of ten months – from October 2016 to July 2017 – and will comprehensively support learning, innovating and implementing new service models. It will comprise:

- Two national events – one at the start and one at the end – with senior national figures
- Between five and seven workshops – one in each locality – with national and local experts from health, housing and care sectors on a range of themes
- Access to expert advice and leads to relevant information and people with on-the-ground experience from the New NHS Alliance and CIH consultancy
- Site visits to meet with professionals and patients/citizens implementing effective programmes in other localities
- Three days of onsite, bespoke advice/consultancy for each group of local partners
- A national learning report that will be published by New NHS Alliance and the CIH consultancy and discussed with NHS England and Department of Health

The national events will engage senior personnel from health and care with partners from local housing providers and strategic housing local authorities.

Participant localities will be invited to identify themes they want to focus on during the locality workshops and we will incorporate these into the programme. Cutting edge themes that have already been identified include:

- Trends and progress in information technology and data-sharing
- Health creation (the 3C's – control, contact, confidence)
- Building a business case for wellbeing – the evidence and economics
- Action to address health inequalities in localities
- Outcome focused initiatives to improve health outcomes

Throughout the programme, we will draw on the huge breadth of case study examples now available to learn about what works and how initiatives are built, delivered and funded.

## This programme is open to CCGs, GP Federations, acute trusts, mental health trusts, community trusts, public health

Three named senior professionals from any combination of these in a particular locality can participate. Once you have signed up, we will identify and recruit housing organisations in your locality who are engaged in innovative health and care programmes – from hospital discharge to healthy eating, social prescribing to mental health.

The cost per locality is just £12,500 + VAT. If you want to accelerate your transformation by working with housing and other community-based partners, then this programme is for you.
